Our nature-based programming and engaging outdoor setting provide an excellent early childhood and K-4th experience for children of diverse abilities, and economic and cultural backgrounds.

The benefits of time and play spent in the great outdoors are numerous. Angela Hanscom, a pediatric occupational therapist and founder of TimberNook, has devoted much of her career to educating professionals and parents on how "outdoor play makes for strong, confident, and capable children." She notes that "children today have increasingly sedentary, indoor lifestyles" and points to research that connects this trend "not only with academic difficulties, but also with a number of health and cognitive difficulties, such as attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), emotion regulation and sensory processing issues,"

Angela confidently claims that "nature is the ultimate sensory experience, and that psychological and physical health improves for children when they spend time outside on a regular basis."

She is not alone. A growing body of research supports the necessity of outdoor play for children (and adults, for that matter). Charlotte Mason, ahead of her time in so many ways, also recognized this need. Her methodology cannot be separated from a childhood rich in outdoor, first-hand nature experiences.

Charlotte Mason was a British educator and philosopher in the late 19th and early 20th century, a contemporary of Maria Montessori. Mason developed a philosophy of education that respected the child as an image-bearer and recognized education as a partnership in which the educator, cooperating with and empowered by the Holy Spirit, is tasked with preparing students to fully live out their God-given purposes. She often referred to education as "a feast", emphasizing that students should delight in a full range of studies, which should be presented in a way that is both enriching and enjoyable.

Our Form 1 Program will be utilizing the Alveary curriculum to provide students with a high-quality education that stays true to Mason's philosophy while equipping students with the skills and worldview foundation vital to living well in today's world.

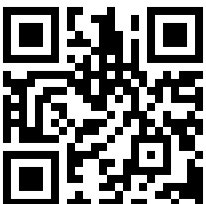
